## INLAND EMPIRE PECG 2011 SCHOLARSHIP

The Inland Empire Section of the Professional Engineers in California Government is offering a \$1,000 Scholarship to encourage students in pursuit of a college degree. Preference will be given to those students pursuing a Landscape Architecture, Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Geological Sciences, or Land Surveying Degree.

All scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific goals and experience.

### Applicant Requirements:

- Families of members (as opposed to fee payers and non-members) of the Inland Empire Section of PECG, which includes children, spouses or other legal dependents, as defined in California Family Code Section 297 are eligible to apply for the scholarship.
- Members of the Inland Empire Section of PECG are also eligible to apply for the scholarship.

### Selection Criteria:

- Candidates must be accepted to enroll in an ABET certified curriculum at a community college, state college or university, or currently enrolled in a college or university; and will have graduated from high school or be in possession of a GED certificate by the end of June of the year in which the applicant is applying.
- Preferential consideration will be given to those candidates majoring in professional fields represented by PECG as noted in PECG's Memorandum of Understanding, and to those applicants who have not been a previous IEPECG scholarship recipient.
- Work experience and/or volunteer experience will be considered.
- School involvement will be considered.
- Letters of recommendation will be considered.

**YOUR APPLICATION PACKAGE SHOULD INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING  
INFORMATION IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED COMPLETE:**

1. **Scholarship application with volunteer/school involvement experience**
2. **Current resume with work experience**
3. **A personal statement not to exceed 500 words**
4. **At least two letters of recommendation**
5. **Your signed scholarship distribution consent form (Please note that your signed Scholarship Distribution Consent Form will be required before any scholarship funds can be distributed.)**

- **Your resume must contain the following information:**

**PERSONAL INFORMATION:**

Your first and last name, address, city, state, phone number, and email address (if you have one) should appear in the resume.

**HIGH SCHOOL:**

If you are currently attending high school, please include the school office phone number, your GPA, or copy of GED with copy of school transcript through the fall 2010 Semester (a non-official copy will suffice). If you have graduated from high school prior to fall 2010, you do not need to include this information.

**COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL ACTIVITIES:**

Include school clubs and activities such as Mathematics Engineering Science Achievement (MESA), National Honor Society, debate team, student government, mentoring, sports, etc. Also include community and volunteer participation such as church organizations, Habitat for Humanity, Rotary Club etc.

**COLLEGE:**

Name and location of the college or university you plan to attend and major course of study. If you are currently attending a college or university, please provide a copy of your school transcript through the Fall 2010 Semester/Quarter (a non-official copy will suffice).

**WORK EXPERIENCE:**

Include paid and volunteer experience outside of school.

- **Your Personal Statement should include:**

Your college and career plans and what you hope to accomplish. Also, how you believe you can make a contribution to your current or planned field of study. *Your personal statement should be typed, and should not exceed 500 words.*

- **Letters of Recommendation:**

Include at least two letters of recommendation from individuals, such as teachers, professionals, clergy, mentors, etc. (other than those related family members as defined in the criteria section). The letters should address the candidate's character, skill and/or potential to be successful in their field of choice.

- Each recipient shall receive an initial amount of half the value of the scholarship.
- The remainder of the scholarship may not be released to the recipient until the completion of the first quarter or semester, whichever is appropriate, and subject to the student providing proof of attendance in school for not less than half time enrollment and maintaining at least a 2.0 GPA.
