



INLAND EMPIRE PECG 2008 SCHOLARSHIP

The Inland Empire Section of the Professional Engineers in California Government is offering two \$500 Scholarships to encourage students in pursuit of a college degree. Preference will be given to those students pursuing an Architecture, Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Geological Sciences, or Land Surveying Degree.

All scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific goals and experience.

Applicant Requirements:

- Families of members (as opposed to fee payers and non-members) of the Inland Empire Section of PECG, which includes children, spouses or other legal dependents, as defined in California Family Code Section 297 are eligible to apply for the scholarship.
- Members of the Inland Empire Section of PECG are also eligible to apply for the scholarship.

Selection Criteria:

- Candidates must be accepted to enroll in an ABET certified curriculum at a community college, state college or university, or currently enrolled in a college or university; and will have graduated from high school or be in possession of a GED certificate by the end of June of the year in which the applicant is applying.
- Preferential consideration will be given to those candidates majoring in professional fields represented by PECG as noted in PECG's Memorandum of Understanding, and to those applicants who have not been a previous IEPEG scholarship recipient.
- Work experience and/or volunteer experience will be considered.
- School involvement will be considered.
- Letters of recommendation will be considered.

2008 SCHOLARSHIP DISTRIBUTION CONSENT FORM

Each scholarship recipient shall receive a total amount of the scholarship to be distributed as follows:

- Each recipient shall receive an initial amount of half the value of the scholarship.
- The remainder of the scholarship may not be released to the recipient until the completion of the first quarter or semester, whichever is appropriate, and subject to the student providing proof of attendance in school for not less than half time enrollment and maintaining at least a 2.0 GPA.

Any amount not distributed by February 1, of the following year in which the scholarship was awarded will revert to the property of Inland Empire PEGC.
